

Formed in 1992

Incorporated organisation based in Amsterdam (and Dubai)

Secretariat for the RIPE community

RIR for Europe, the Middle East and Parts of Central Asia

15,000+ members and growing

Not-for-profit



Not "just" an RIR

Formed by the RIPE community to act as secretariat and carry out activities on its behalf

To facilitate the community to gather online and in person

Got the "blessing" from the community to become an RIR shortly afterwards

 - support of local events






How we can make more affordable to RIPE NCC?
