PDO Update

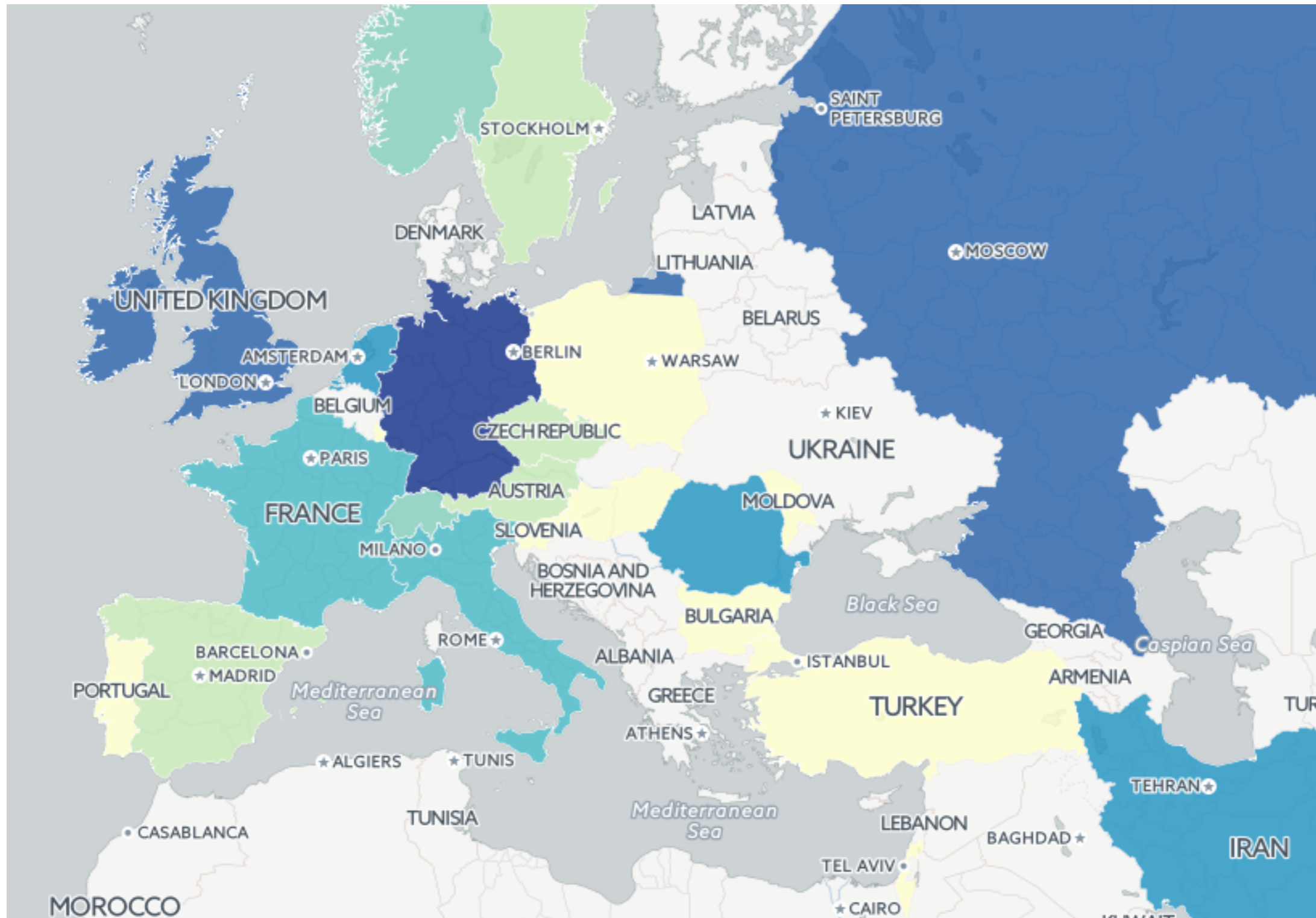
Address Policy Engagement
